Sir

I am aware of the proposed building on the Green Belt area at Blackwell Farm that the University of Surrey own. I would like to express my objection to this on several issues.

There is no evidence that the proposed area should be taken out of Green Belt. Much of the land is a flood plain which would be completely unsuitable for any construction.

There is a plan to use the Farnham Road as the main entrance to the proposed building. The Farnham Road is an extremely busy road with just one lane in each direction. The road towards Guildford is always at a stand-still every morning and most evenings. Further traffic would be unsustainable. The proposed road to the estate would cut across ANOB land, require the removal of numerous ancient trees and woodland, add noise and light pollution and affect the air quality to an unacceptable level.

The Blackwell Farm plan should be rejected.
